NIECH ŻYJE BAL...

W piękny, chociaż mroźny wieczór 15 lutego 2025 r. odbył się wspaniały bal walentynkowy w Polskiej Szkole

Katolickiej im. św. Ferdynanda, starannie przygotowany przez niezastąpiony Komitet Rodzicielski. Była to cudowna noc wypełniona radością i śmiechem, a w gronie naszych najbliższych nabrała jeszcze bardziej niezwykłego charakteru, pełnego ciepła i niezapomnianych wspomnień.

Bal rozpoczął się o godzinie 19.00 od przywitania gości przez panią Dyrektorkę szkoły Haliną Żurawską i przewodniczącą Komitetu Rodzicielskiego panią Annę Panek. Następnie wszystkim zgromadzonym w JCT ksiądz Proboszcz Piotr Gnoiński udzielił błogosławieństwa, życząc wymśnieną zabawę taneczną.
