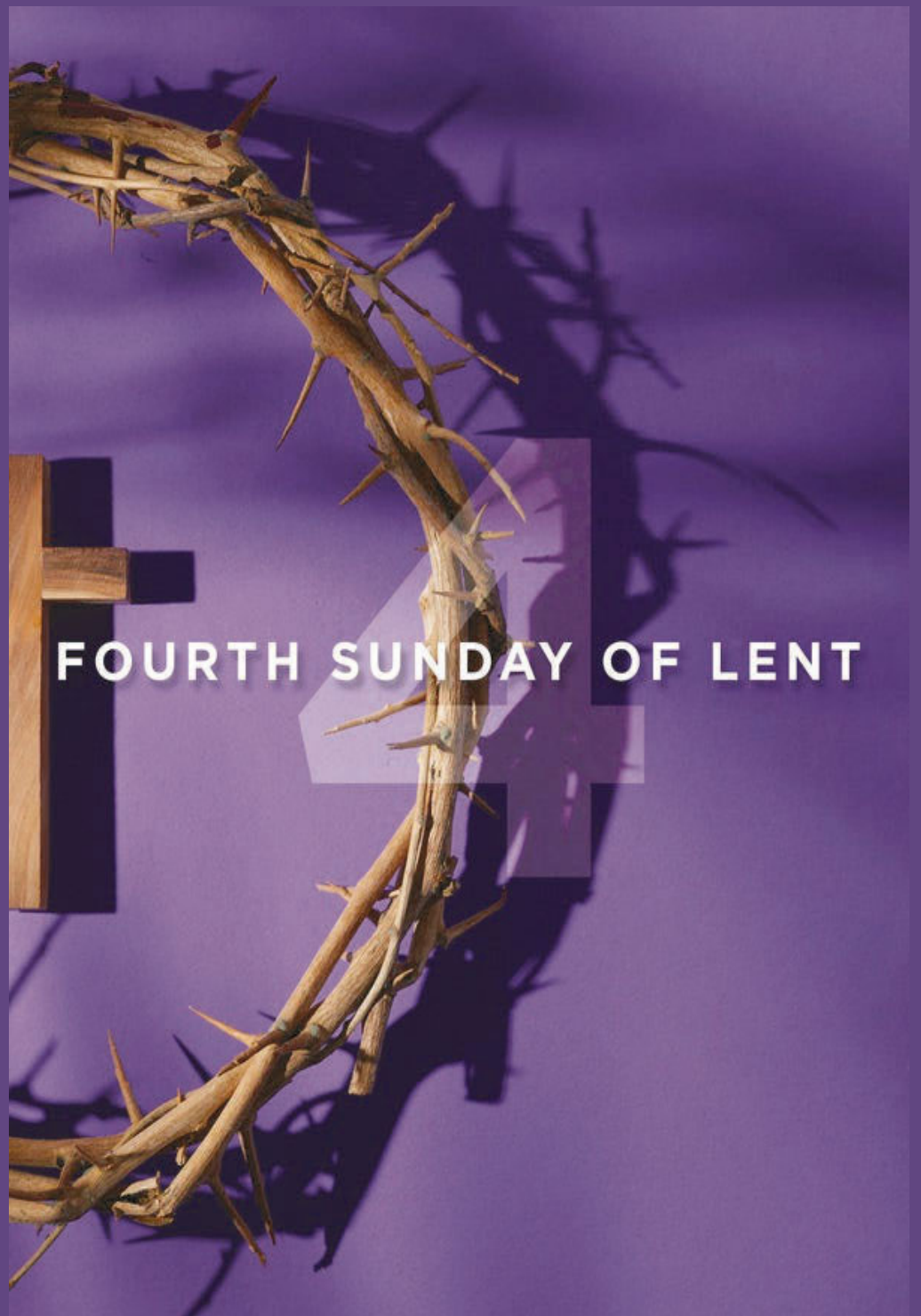

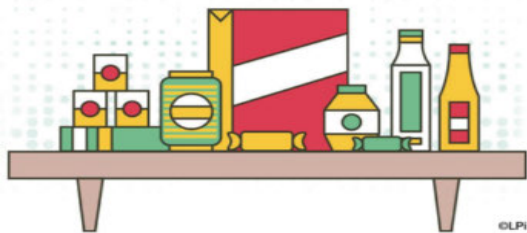

## LABYRINTH AT St. Mother Guerin parish

Mother Guerin parish would like to invite you to walk the Labyrinth during Holy Week at St. Celestine (3020 N. 76th Court, Elmwood Park; enter through the Annex door in the parking lot) April 13—18. Hours: Sunday, April 13 Noon—5 PM, April 14—17 4—9 PM, and April 18, Good Friday 9 AM—9 PM. Early in Church history going on "the Way" or, later, on a "pilgrimage" to places such as Guadalupe, Czestochowa and Compostella were seen as a prayer discipline. During the Middle Ages when the Crusades closed the route of Christian pilgrims to the Holy Land, two forms of walking meditation surfaced: the "Stations of the Cross" and the labyrinth.

Perhaps the best known labyrinth in this tradition is the one on the floor of Chartres Cathedral in France which is the one our St. Celestine Labyrinth is based upon.
